1. The “Whoppers” should be short (humorous, dramatic, supernatural, etc.) with a maximum length of 5 minutes (Timing devices will be used.)
Anyone exceeding the time limit of 5 minutes 30 seconds will be disqualified.
2. Deadline for registration - **June 11 – 6:30 P.M.**
3. **Judging** will be done by a panel of three storytelling experts who will score each contestant in the following categories:
 - a. **Technique** – delivery , general stage presence.
 - b. **Story Development** – of the tale in time available.
 - c. **Originality**– new material or fresh handling of a familiar yarn.
 - d. **Effectiveness**– taking audience response into consideration.
